




How to resize an image using Adobe Photoshop

1. Visit <https://photoshop.adobe.com> - this is a free, limited version of Adobe Photoshop which you can use to resize your photos.
2. Click the blue “upload file” button to select the image you want to resize




3. Once your image has loaded, click “Crop and straighten” from the menu on the left-hand side.



- Then, from the menu on the right-hand side, select the “Photos” dropdown and select “Square”. This makes sure your image is the right size to be cropped for the locket.

Click the blue “Crop Image” button at the bottom of the menu, to save your changes.




- Then, go back into the “Crop and straighten” menu, and select the circle from the bottom of the right-hand menu, under “Shapes”.




Click the blue “Crop Image” button again, to save your changes. Your image should now look something similar to the below and the corners of the image should be a white and grey checkered pattern.



6. Next, go back to the menu on the left-hand side and click “Resize image”.



10. At the top of the menu that opens on the right-hand side, change the size to 57 px for both Width and Height.
Click the blue “Resize image” button to apply your changes.



11. Finally, you need to download your image by clicking the “Download” button in the top-right-hand side of the screen.



12. Save your image wherever you'd prefer on your device. Once saved, you can print the image out and cut it to size, ensuring there's no white border around the photo. It should be a circle; but don't worry if it's not perfect!

You can print on a paper thickness of your choice, however we would recommend between 180gsm (0.16mm) and 400gsm (0.43mm) thick. You can use a speciality photo paper if you prefer.

You're now free to add your picture to your Deia Locket, but please recycle any leftover paper!
